Volkswagen Cabriolet: Your Guide to The Trunk

Appearance upon opening the trunk lid:





with factory rear shoulder belts

White sticker is the build sheet sticker with the car's factory data.

Side panels:



1979-1993Right side shown; left side is the same but with cutout for light



1991.5-1993 with factory rear shoulder belts

Round hole is for optional trunk-mounted CD changer, and for access to emergency manual override of power-top pump

Carpet:



Contoured, rubber-backed, low pile outdoor-type carpet

Carpet simply lays in trunk over spare tire

Spare tire:



1979-1984

Full-size spare with jack and lug wrench; tool kit is strapped inside the spare via a hooked rubber band

Alloy vs. steel wheel: Matches what the other 4 wheels that came on the car from the factory.



1984.5-1993

"Donut" spare with tool kit (jack, lug wrench and screw driver); tool kit is strapped inside the spare via a hooked rubber band

Modifications:

To reduce wear on carpet and to have a sturdier floor, have a piece of ¼" plywood cut to width of narrowest part of trunk and place it under the carpet.
